The member will be fully responsible for the operation of a "borrowed" boat and must carry the temporary registration slip at all times on the lake and must be turned in at the gate when leaving. TEMPORARY REGISTRATION FORMS ARE AVAILABLE AT LSA OFFICE.

* Maximum length for power/fishing boats 17', pontoon 20' and will be checked according to manufacturer's specifications and State Watercraft Card.

** Applicable only to boats which are required to be registered under Illinois Water Safety Act. A copy of current State Registration card must be stapled to this form.

***Under Lake Summerset regulations, this is required only for boats having motors exceeding 10 horsepower. A copy of the certificate of liability insurance must be stapled to this form.
